Inclusion in education is an approach to educating students with special needs. ... **Inclusion** rejects the use of special **schools** or classrooms to separate students with disabilities from students without disabilities .Inclusive Education needs formal educational system along with the special remedial education in the same educational institution .The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009,means that every child has a right to full time elementary education of satisfactory and equitable quality in a formal school which satisfies certain essential norms and standards.

All children benefit from inclusive education. It allows them to:

- Develop individual strengths and gifts, with high and appropriate expectations for each child.
- Work on individual goals while participating in the life of the classroom with other students their own age.
- Involve their parents in their education and in the activities of their local schools.
- Foster a school culture of respect and belonging. Inclusive education provides opportunities to learn about and accept individual differences, lessening the impact of harassment and bullying.
- Develop friendships with a wide variety of other children, each with their own individual needs and abilities.
- Positively affect both their school and community to appreciate diversity and inclusion on a broader level.

Garden Reach Institution for Rehabilitation and Research is a social innovation platform that act as a catalyst to positively impact marginalized communities to realize their potential through rights, protection, sports, education and livelihood. Garden Reach Institution for Rehabilitation and Research(GRIRR) is committed to support the journey of children to attain self-reliant adulthood through quality education ,therapeutic service and job placement. The organization has served the community sincerely but silently since 2014 in Garden Reach. Garden Reach Institution for Rehabilitation and Research is an institute that is trying to provide the inclusive education to the children with special needs.

Garden Reach Institute for the Rehabilitation and Research also incubates values of inclusive society and works with children and young adults with special needs. It is designed for that reason. GRIRR is working directly at the grassroots level with the economically and socially underprivileged to make education accessible and relevant.

Children are reached out, screened through specialized tools and mainstream supports are provided through parents training, support on orientation and nobilities, school preparedness, enrollment and pedagogical support to attain academic skills. Therefore, the education opportunities imparted by GRIRR is in formal and special learning format. GRIRR provide the therapy and education for all children with special needs.

The working Process of GRIRR for making inclusive set up

Survey and Screening: GRIRR team conducts door to door Survey at different Areas and screen children based on the observation and previous medical records.

Testing and certification: GRIRR refers children to appropriate facilities to obtain required testing and certifications.

Assessment: Assessment is done by the different tools that are developed by the special educators.

Goal Selection : The different goals are set based on children's strength and needs.

I.E.P.(Individualized Educational Programme): Based on mainstream goals, curriculum adaptation plans and Individualized Educational Programme are prepared along with the inclusive set up.

School Enrolment: Enrollment supports are provided to local formal schools, special schools and based on circumstances of children and their families.

Special Learning methods adopted by GRIRR :

GRIRR adopts some methods which are usually followed by the special educators and teachers for different types of children with special needs-

Mental Retardation: Demonstration, Colour Coding, Picture method, Modeling, Peer Education, I.E.P Methods along with special teaching learning materials.

Hearing Impairment: Visual and video based training, Picture method ,Basic sign languages, Gestures ,Colour coding with special teaching learning materials.

Visual Impairment: Audio method ,VAKT method (Visual Auditory Kinesthetic Tactile) and for total blind only Auditory Kinesthetic Tactile method along with comprehension type question method.

Autism: I.E.P, music-sound method ,Colour-Size-shape method, Time out method ,ADL(Activities of Daily Life) activity.



Learning Disability: Special Remedial Teaching after identifying their problem area in each type of learning disability including

Dyslexia

Dysgraphia

Dyscalculia

.Slow Learner: Motivation, discussion ,Time out method, Reinforcements.

Multiple Disability: ADL,I.E.P.

Cerebral Palsy: ADL,I.E.P.

Evaluation: After Special Remedial teaching each children are evaluated and then next level plans are designed





GRIRR Physiotherapy unit which evaluate the child to be able and make them independent as much as possible in their life through the Rehabilitation therapy and ADL training .So the children can have the social participation as other children whether in school ,in society ,or family function. Children Mobility and independency are very important Because Most of the children who are Dependent they won't have opportunities to include in such of these.

During SMART Goal setting we include Parents or care taker to understand the goal as per the child ability then Discuss Rehab plan for center as well as teach them Home base plan.

Rehabilitation Service which include:

- 1) Screening: To understand what type of disability present.
- 2) Assessment: include Physical and social problems
- 3) Referral: If they need Any specific test or treatment
- 4) Rehab intervention plan: including therapy, ADL training, Appliances etc.
- 5) Goal setting: Which include Short & long term goal.
- 6) Assistive devices: include orthosis.
- 7) Developmental aids: Include corner seat, Special chair, Standing frame etc.
- 8) ADL devices: include Modified Spoon and brush.
- 9) Home base program to parents: In which demonstrate the parents home base technique.

Shakir sk. Is the 1st child of Badrujamal Sk. And Ujala bibi. He was born in 2012 at Home. When he was only 6 month old he got fever and epilepsy and he diagnosed as Cerebral palsy Spastic Quadriplegia.

He was unable to control neck, Unable to do rolling, & sit without support. Since January 2017, he has been associated with Garden Reach Institute for the Rehabilitation and Research and been receive regular Therapy and Assistive device other service from there. Today he is able to hold neck & do rolling, Able to sit with minimum support and response to sound & light, make noise, Now he likes to listen music. After seeing his achievement his parents are very happy and they are very kind to GRIRR staffs. As per mother want his child to give better education to him for his better life.

FARHAN ALI

Farhan Ali born on 2014, he was the 2nd child of SK. Yasin Ali & Sajda Khatoon. He live with his grandmother and his main care taker is aunty. He was born in a Government hospital with delay birth cry and have jaundice after birth. He had referred to NIMH for early intervention. Where he diagnosed as cerebral palsy spastic Diplegia. He was unable to sit without support and unable to crawl & stand without support. Since 2016 he has been associated with GRIRR and receiving Regular therapy and assistive device and other services from there.

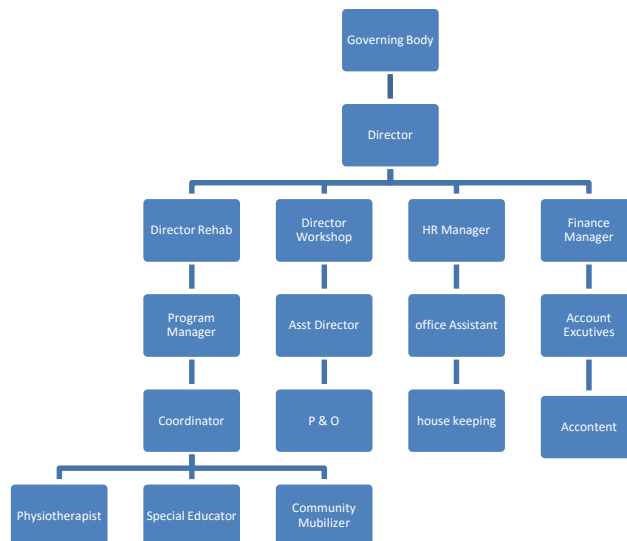


Today he able to sit without support and stand with wall support, able to walk with the help of B/L AFO & Reverse walker independently. Farhan like to play with Football. His family are very positive to the child disability. His mother says because he can sit now so she will admit in tuition by this year then she will plan to admit in local government school.



GRIRR is a Social Organization registered under West Bengal Societies Registration Act 1961. The highest decision making body is the Governing Body consisting of nine members. Day to day management of the programme is done by the Director of GRIRR in consultation with secretary and the president.

The Program Manager and unit heads are the top implementing body of the project running in GRIRR by putting shape to the policies and strategic plans. They all are working as per advice of the Director. Team members are encouraged to improve their technical and management skills by participating in training workshops.
